### Our Vision...



## Something Helpful...

Nothing at this moment matters, but as you move forward you might find this information helpful.

- Obtain multiple copies of death certificates (5-10). The cost is between \$20-\$25 ea. (A certified copy of the death certificate will be needed by insurance co., utilities, all benefit providers 401K, retirement, investments, HSA...).
- Seek Grief Counseling.
- Contact an Attorney (they can help with the estate, will, and guidance through legalities).
- Contact an Accountant for tax filing.
- Contact a Financial Planner.
- Contact Social Security regarding spouse benefits and to obtain a one-time death benefit.
- Contact deceased spouse's employer to obtain life insurance, 401K, retirement, HSA benefits
- Follow up with Life insurance companies
- Contact your bank about accounts.
- Close any credit card accounts in the deceased spouse's name.
- Cancel cell phone plan in the deceased's name
- In Ohio, if you have vehicles in the deceased spouse's name, the surviving spouse is entitled to transfer 2 of those vehicles into your name without going through the estate.
- If the deceased spouse was a veteran and honorably discharged they are entitled to a military service and grave marker. The veteran's DD214 form will be required.
- You can, but you do not have to transfer utilities from the deceased spouse's name.
- Don't make any big decisions right away i.e. moving, selling house, removing personal belongings. If you're able, give yourself 1 year to make these decisions.
- You're not alone. Ask for help.
